


This Winter...

Many refugees will be living in overcrowded, enclosed camps, forced to worry about the bitter cold among every other challenge they face. Innocent children won't be able to feel the warmth of their favourite blankets or cuddly toys they left behind at home. With millions displaced this year, millions of winters will be unfamiliar.

Yet for many others, winter will remain the same as last year. Temperatures dropping below zero degrees at night. The risk of illness a constant threat. Livelihoods disrupted and income reduced - especially those reliant on agriculture. A lack of food and water as a result. The same struggles as last year.


This winter, people will suffer greatly. But we have the opportunity to take some of that suffering away.

Across these three countries, millions of refugees and internally displaced people (in Yemen and Sudan) have had no choice but to flee their homes – their safe spaces – with many now residing in makeshift tents, no doubt an indescribably difficult transition. During the winter, tents can easily be damaged, adding to this trauma. This leaves vulnerable people with no roof over their heads for a second time. GRF is providing shelters to protect refugees and internally displaced people, shielding individuals and their tents from the rain and strong winds.

EMERGENCY WINTER APPEAL: Palestine (Gaza)

Your compassion can save a life this winter

1.9 Million displaced.

1.84 Million experiencing critical levels of acute food insecurity.

Over **2 million people** in Gaza are experiencing immense suffering. This winter, dropping temperatures and strong winds threaten to make matters much worse. People are already reliant on food and water aid, but in winter, they also need thermal clothing and shoes to stay warm and protected from illnesses such as pneumonia. Families need blankets and mattresses to stay covered during the night; babies urgently need milk and nappies; people are in dire need of shelter. With the healthcare system already experiencing unimaginable amounts of strain, the harsh weather can intensify existing health concerns. The extreme lack of hygiene facilities makes the population of Gaza even more vulnerable to the spread of illness during winter.

Famine imminent in the North of Gaza. Polio has re-emerged in Gaza after 25 years, due to unsanitary water.

People have had to leave behind everything they own in search of safety for themselves and their families, including **clothes**, **shoes** and any other form of physical protection. In these new surroundings, many families find it alarmingly difficult to obtain essential food supplies, with several living in small Families in Lebanon were already facing significant challenges due to high inflation rates and ongoing economic hardships, making it difficult to afford essential items. Over 2.6 million Syrian and Palestinian **refugees** live in Jordan. Among them, several have restricted access to electricity and families have limited availability to resources such as blankets. These concerns are present all year round but are amplified in winter. **The lack of electricity and heating leaves people struggling** to sleep comfortably during the night and limited resources means a family may have no choice but to share winter items like a single blanket among themselves. Families also become **prone to illnesses** – another worry they must carry with them during the difficult winter months.

The conflict in Sudan has resulted in one of the highest levels of acute malnutrition rates, particularly for children in the world.

The ongoing **violence** has also triggered mass internal displacement, many who have been forced to move are reliant on aid for basic needs such as water, hygiene, shelter and food. With Winter quickly approaching and temperatures dropping in the night, the already existing humanitarian crisis is expected to worsen.

With this, the need for mattresses, blankets and winter kits is as high as ever.
