However, the crisis is far from over. Gazans remain under threat every single day. GRF is committed to aiding in the betterment of Palestinian lives and in helping the people of Gaza to survive.



Understanding the Crisis

The current conflict triggered by the events of October 2023 has resulted in the damage and destruction of Gazan infrastructure, economy and lives. There have been detrimental impacts to wellbeing, service provision and hugely limited access to essential resources. A large portion of the population has also become vulnerable to disease outbreaks and severe war-related injuries.

GRF'S Immediate Actions

GRF has had a sustained presence in Palestine for over 10 years. From the inception of the crisis, the team held regular emergency meetings to assess the day-by-day outcomes and review changing needs. The field team conducted rapid needs and risk assessments while we evaluated the readiness and logistical ability of the team to work in a hostile environment. As a result of our emergency preparedness, the field team was able to aid right from the start.

Food and Water



GRF uses networks with local Palestinian businesses and traders, transporting food aid through the Rafah and Jordanian borders. This includes acquiring, packaging, transporting and distributing food items.



Medical Aid



GRF works with senior teams and medical practitioners in several hospitals including Nasser and Hayfa Hospitals. We provide critical medical equipment and medicines to treat war-related & routine health conditions.

Shelter & Hygiene Items



GRF distributed shelters in the South of Gaza for displaced persons who otherwise had no means of shelter. The team obtained and transported hygiene kits containing essential sanitary products including female-specific items.

Projects Implemented

With your support, we have been able to provide aid to millions of vulnerable people in Gaza.

Food Aid



Vegetable parcels, hot meals, food parcels, flour trucks, bread and Qurbani benefitting **1.1 million** since 2023

Medical Aid



Medicines such as painkillers, gauze, casts, crutches, equipment for amputation and surgical equipment

Shelter



30 shelters benefitting **180+** people

Water Aid



164 water tankers and trucks benefitting **800,000+**
Construction of a solar-powered water well

Hygiene Kits



1,010 packs containing essential sanitary items such as soap, shampoo and toothpaste, benefitting **6,060** people

Delivering Hope: Our Logistics Network

The political landscape in Gaza is ever-changing, therefore our strong local connections allow us to gather vital information and conduct the most effective course of action. We are able to maintain constant communication with the field team, allowing us to adapt our approach and act fast.

GRF has delivered aid through various channels, including the Rafah border crossing, from the Jordanian border and directly from North Gaza to South Gaza. We recognise the importance of being agile, which is why we adjust routes to adapt to the situation. The team is constantly on the move and delivers aid to the warehouse via trucks, where it is then packed, before being brought to shelters and distributed.

I am from Bayt Laahya in Gaza. I was pregnant during the war. I travelled to be with my parents to give birth, leaving my son and husband in North Gaza. 3 months after I gave birth, my newborn baby was killed in an airstrike while we resided in a school. It took a long time to recover my newborn baby's body and I still don't know where he is buried. I haven't seen my husband or first child since the start of the conflict. My husband never got to meet his newborn child. I am struggling to eat and find food because of everything that is happening. I dream of the day where I am reunited with my husband and son.

This is just one of thousands of stories from Gaza.





Looking Ahead: GRF's Vision for Gaza

GRF is committed to helping Gaza, while the conflict is ongoing and after it comes to an end.

In the short-term, we hope to continue providing medical aid, expand food distribution and build more shelters. We want to provide the people of Gaza with what they need to survive.

In the long-term, our aim is to support the rebuilding and rehabilitation of Gaza, including building homes, education facilities, healthcare infrastructures and sustainable development projects.

Food Parcel and Hygiene Kits Trucks

Help us send two trucks containing vital aid to Gaza. The first truck will provide 770 food parcels containing essential foodstuffs with high nutritional value to sustain a family of up to 6 for weeks, many of which struggle to obtain the necessary nutritional daily intake. The second truck will provide 770 hygiene kits containing the most vital items needed for sanitation and welfare, enabling people to live with dignity and reduce the risk of general health conditions spread by a lack of sanitary facilities.
